
Passover:

Atonement:

- Only High Priest is working.
- All others observe in rest.
- Different sacrifice bull and goats.
- Corporate purification and union.
- Repeat every year.
- Temporary limited results.
- Foreshadows Jesus.



ATONEMENT:— reconciliation, agreement; satisfaction or reparation for a wrong or injury; amends.

Theology—the doctrine concerning the reconciliation of God and humankind, especially as accomplished through the life, suffering, and death of Christ.

degree.


For Our Propitiation God Condemned Sin In Jesus Romans 8:3 "For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh," (KATAKRINO)

The Godhead Was Involved In The Act Of Propitiation 2 Corinthians 5:19

"that is, that <u>God was in Christ</u> reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation."


God's Wrath Poured On Sin Secures Our Propitiation Romans 5:9

"I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins."



Guilt is anger directed at ourselves at what we did or did not do.







Some are experts blaming others for everything and anything else.


