Psalms 103 (NLT)

"Let all that I am praise the Lord; with my whole heart, I will praise his holy name. **2** Let all that I am praise the Lord; may I never forget the good things he does for me. **3** He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. **4** He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. **5** He fills my life with good things. My youth is renewed like the eagle's! **6** The Lord gives righteousness and justice to all who are treated unfairly. **7** He revealed his character to Moses and his deeds to the people of Israel. **8** The Lord is compassionate and merciful, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love. 9 He will not constantly accuse us, nor remain angry forever. **10** He does not punish us for all our sins; he does not deal harshly with us, as we deserve. **11** For his unfailing love toward those who fear him is as great as the height of the heavens above the earth. **12** He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west. **13** The Lord is like a father to his children, tender and compassionate to those who fear him. **14** For he knows how weak we are; he remembers we are only dust. **15** Our days on earth are like grass; like wildflowers, we bloom and die. **16** The wind blows, and we are gone— as though we had never been here. **17** But the love of the Lord remains forever with those who fear him. His salvation extends to the children's children **18** of those who are faithful to his covenant, of those

who obey his commandments! **19** The Lord has made the heavens his throne: from there he rules over everything. **20** Praise the Lord, you angels, you mighty ones who carry out his plans, listening for each of his commands. **21** Yes, praise the Lord, you armies of angels who serve him and do his will! **22** Praise the Lord, everything he has created, everything in all his kingdom. Discussion Questions

- 1. Have you ever had a benefit package at work or school? What did it include? What did you have to do to access these benefits?
- 2. Read Ps. 103. Find and discuss the benefits described in our relationship with the Father. Share one way that you have benefited in life through your relationship with God.
- 3. Discuss what this means: "Forgiveness is not something that God does, it's something that he has done."

- 8. How can we be so sure that with God "satisfaction is guaranteed?" What are some of the effects of being satisfied in / by God. How do we experience this?
